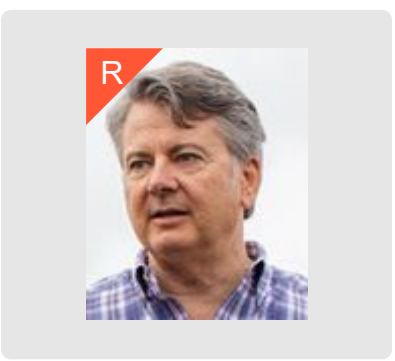

Background

A crop nursery owner and property rights activist, Duarte aims to advance conservative fiscal priorities and to promote water storage

A native of California's Central Valley, Duarte often refers to himself as the grandson of immigrants and a fourth-generation farmer in California's Central Valley; started his career at Duarte Nursery after college

Led product sales and development, and internal and client management of Duarte Nursery; sharpened his business skills at the University of the Pacific, where he obtained his MBA in 1997

Since 2007, he has been president of Duarte Nursery, overseeing the strategy and operations of Duarte Farms with a "major focus on customer and industry relations and technology," according to his LinkedIn profile

Focusing on fiscal responsibility and water storage, Duarte prevailed in the June 2022 primary over state Assm. Member Adam Gray (D-CA21) 34% to 31%, with both advancing to the general election
