Background

Former mayor who aims to apply her record of law enforcement funding, low taxes, and conservative values to the federal level

A granddaughter of immigrants and a first-generation college graduate, Chavez-DeRemer helped start a small business, Anesthesia Associates Northwest, with her husband, who is an anesthesiologist; they now operate several medical clinics in the region

Entered public service by serving on the parks committee for her town of Happy Valley, Oregon, and later on the Happy Valley City Council

Elected as mayor of Happy Valley in 2010, becoming the first woman and Latina to do so and served for two terms; as mayor Chavez-DeRemer balanced the city's budget, kept taxes at low levels, increased police presence and funding in the city, and offered more affordable housing options

In 2016 and 2018, she did not win in the general election for state legislature in Oregon's 51st District, losing by 2% and 8%, respectively
